Having read this waiver and knowing these facts and in consideration of your accepting my entry, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release Lakeview Center, Inc., Baptist Health Care, and any city, county, state, and national government entity, including Santa Rosa Island Authority and Escambia County, Florida, responsible for areas used in conjunction with this event, and all sponsors, their representatives and successors from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event, even though that liability may arise out of negligence on the part of persons named in this waiver. 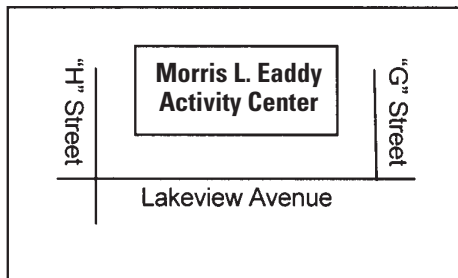
